FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. WHERE DO WE PARK?

A. Parking is free with ticket purchase at multiple locations: Church Parking Lot accessed through driveway between 53 and 63 West Church Street; Christian Education Parking Lot accessed on Wall Street (Extension); 4 handicap spaces on Heckewelder Street.

Q. IS CENTRAL MORAVIAN CHURCH HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE?

A. Yes, guests can be dropped off at the handicap entrance to the church, located off Heckewelder Street on the northeast corner of the church and there are 4 handicap spaces on Heckewelder Street. Handicap spaces are also available in Christian Education Building parking lot.

Q. IS SEATING RESERVED?

A. No, seating is general admission and is first come, first served.

Q. WHAT HAPPENS IF I ARRIVE LATE?

A. Doors open at 6:15 PM and the program begins promptly at 7:00 PM. If you arrive late, please enter through the southwest and northwest doors (entrances accessible from Main Street).

Q. IS THIS PROGRAM APPROPRIATE FOR TEENS AND CHILDREN?

A. The content of this program is not recommended for young children, but may be appropriate for older teens.

Q. IS FOOD SERVED AT THIS EVENT?
